

COOKIE POLICY

As our websites use cookies, please read this policy carefully as it contains important information about who we are and how we use cookies on our websites. This policy should be read together with our privacy notices which set out how and why we collect, store, use and share personal information generally in relation to website use, as well as your rights in relation to your personal information and details of how to contact us and the relevant data protection regulator if you have a complaint.

1. WHO ARE WE?

If you are viewing this Cookie Policy on www.fusionindustrytaskforce.co.uk, this website is operated by Assystem Energy & Infrastructure Limited ("**Assystem**"). This policy explains how Assystem, and their group companies and affiliates use cookies.

2. OUR WEBSITE

This cookie policy relates to your use of our website: www.fusionindustrytaskforce.co.uk.

We may link to other websites from our websites. These other websites may also use cookies or similar technologies and should have their own separate cookie policies. For privacy information relating to these other websites, please review their cookie policies.

3. WHAT IS A COOKIE

A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your device (e.g. computer, smartphone or other electronic device) when you use our website. These help us recognise you and your device and store some information about your preferences or past use of the website.

For example, we may monitor how many times you visit the website, which pages you go to, traffic data, location data and the originating domain name of a user's internet service provider. This information helps us to build a profile of our users. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

4. YOUR CHOICES ABOUT COOKIES

We will ask for your permission (consent) to place cookies (other than essential cookies) or other similar technologies on your device when you visit our website.

There is a notice on our home page which describes how we use cookies and requests your consent to place cookies on your device.

You can also control and/or delete cookies being placed by configuring your browser. For more details, see aboutcookies.org. You can also delete all cookies that are already on your computer, and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site, and some services and functionalities may not work or stop working properly. For further information on our use of cookies, including a detailed list of your information which we and others may collect through cookies, please see below.

5. OUR USE OF COOKIES

We use cookies on this website to:

- recognise you whenever you visit this website (this speeds up your access to the website as you do not have to log in each time);
- obtain information about your preferences and use of our website;
- carry out surveys, research and statistical analysis to help improve our content, products and services and to help us better understand our users' requirements;
- target our marketing and advertising campaigns more effectively by providing interest-based content that are personalised to your interests; and
- make your online experience more efficient and enjoyable.

6. TYPES OF COOKIES

The cookies we place on your device fall into the following categories:

Essential cookies: these cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work.

Analytical and statistical cookies: these cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous.

Functional cookies: these cookies allow our website to remember the choices you make (such as your username, language, last action and search preferences) and provide enhanced, more personal features. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages. The information collected by these cookies is anonymous and cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

Targeting cookies: these cookies may be set through our site by our advertising partners. They uniquely identify your browser and internet device to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other sites. We will use this information to record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

Social media cookies: these cookies are set by a range of social media services that we have added to the site to enable you to share our content with your friends and networks. They can track your browser across other sites and building up a profile of your interests. This may impact the content and messages you see on other websites you visit. If you do not allow these cookies you may not be able to use or see these sharing tools.

7. DURATION OF COOKIES

The cookies we place on your device are stored for the following duration:

Session cookies: these allow our website to link your actions during a particular browser session. These expire each time you close your browser and do not remain on your device afterwards.

Persistent cookies: these are stored on your device in between browser sessions. These allow your preferences or actions across our website to be remembered. These will remain on your device until they expire, or you delete them from your cache. Details of their duration are set out below.

8. THE COOKIES WE USE

The table below provides more information about the cookies we use and why:

Google Analytics	Web analytics service provided by Google that tracks and reports website traffic	From length of Session (for as long as the user has the window open) to days or weeks (determined by website operator once website live) (up to two years)	Collects information such as the user's device and browser type, IP address, and website interactions (pages visited, links clicked, etc.). This data is typically used to analyze website traffic, user behavior, and demographics, helping website owners understand how visitors interact with their site and make improvements accordingly

9. BLOCKING OR DISABLING COOKIES

Cookies can be managed in different ways: depending on your preferences, you can authorise, refuse, or deactivate them. You can express your choices and modify your wishes through your browser: the configuration of each browser is different. It is up to you to follow the instructions of the editor of your browser. We draw your attention to the fact that the total rejection of cookies may lead to some of our services being inaccessible or to a less efficient or less adapted use of our services.
